

SPECIAL CONDITIONS - Continued

2. ANOS (QLD) KABI Group Inc. or its agents accept no responsibility for the theft, loss, destruction or damage of any kind to plants either during transport to or from the show or while at the show for display or sale. All reasonable care will be taken.

3. The Show Marshal shall have the right to refuse the exhibition of any plant which in his/her opinion appears diseased, has insect pests on the plant or not of show bench quality. The Show Marshall may reject, remove or rearrange any entry and combine and/or establish extra classes if needed. **The Show Marshal's decision is final.**

4. Plants competing for prizes shall have been owned and in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding six (6) months.

5. Exhibits must be benched by 9.00am on Saturday 27 August 2011. There shall be no restriction on the number of separate entries by the exhibitor in any class or classes. Entries in joint names will be accepted. All plants entered will be judged.

6. Australasian Native Orchid Judging and staking standards apply. No prizes shall be given if, in the opinion of the judges, no prize is warranted. **The judges decision is final.**

7. Exhibits must not be removed from the benches before the termination of the show; no blooms shall be removed from a plant even though spent or plants or blooms interfered with, except under the authority of the Show Marshal.

8. All plant sales, commercial and private, must conform to ANOS definition.

9. Plants from a **Restricted Fire Ant Area** being exhibited or for sale, must be accompanied by appropriate documentation as required by the DPI otherwise the Show Marshal may refuse the exhibition or sale of the plants.

10. Hot/Cold hybrids include **only** section Dendrocoryne together with Section Spatulata and/or Section Phalaenanthe. Sections Dendrocoryne and Spatulata are defined below and Phalaenanthe includes *D. bigibbum* - all varieties and *D. dicuphum*.

11. Section Dendrocoryne includes *D. adae*, *aemulum*, *falcorostrum*, *fleckeri*, *gracilicaule* (all varieties), *jonesii* (all varieties), *kingianum* (all varieties), *moorei*, *speciosum* (all varieties), *tetragonum* (all varieties). ***D. speciosum* (all varieties) is excluded for Class 12.**

12. Section Spatulata includes *D. discolor*, *canaliculatum* - all varieties, *carronii*, *antennatum*, *johannis*, *trilamellatum*, *nindii* and *mirbelianum* for Classes 27 - 30 and New Guinea species also for Classes 13 & 25.

13. Dockrillia species includes all plants that exist on the Australian mainland and islands within the defined ANOS boundaries.

14. Section Latouria includes *D. bifalce* and all New Guinea species from this section.

15. The Champion Hybrid and Champion Species will be eligible for nomination for the Ira Butler or Bill Murdoch Award respectively. The best Spatulata species or hybrid will be eligible for nomination for the Ken McPherson Trophy.

16. A Specimen plant is a many-flowered mature plant that has developed from a single clone

17. All exhibitors must provide the Show Marshal with a list of plants exhibited. Blank lists are available from the Show Marshal.
